- 1 "... .. and Nathan the Prophet anointed Solomon King. And all the people rejoiced, and said: God save the King! Long live the King!" Coronation anthem by G. F. Handel with text from 1 Kings used in England since 1727 (notable for remaining unchanged in coronation of female monarchs because the king in question is Solomon) (5, 3, 6)
- 13 Historical period defined by distinct cultural characteristics (Ottoman, disco etc.)
- 14 Mediterranean island associated with palace at Knossos, labyrinth of Daedalus, octopus pottery and arresting bull-leaping attire
- 15 Hugely popular Melbourne entertainer (with partner Ron Blaskett) (with first initial) (1, 3)
- 16 Violent, uncontrollable anger; late-night TV music show with raucous, grating theme
- 18 Impassioned *TYT* host (not Cenk) (or John)
- 19 Plain in Burma with Buddhist temples
- 20 Algerian port city associated with Rai music and *La Peste* by Camus
- 21 Greatly loved American artist (*Saying Grace, The Problem We All Live With* etc.) (initials)
- 22 Spanish horror film by Alejandro Amenábar with Nicole Kidman as ghost who doesn't realize that she and her children are dead (or that she killed them) (initials)

- 30 Latin prefix meaning new (Classicism, Nazi, Con etc.)

- 33 Nigerian uranium (initials)

- 40 "I live with melancholy" French for sadness (as in risible 1958 art film with David Niven as wastrel playboy father, Deborah Kerr as tragic, uptight love interest and Jean Seberg as titular melancholy airhead directed by Otto Preminger much admired by François Truffaut and Jean-Luc Godard who famously said *Breathless* could begin exactly where it ends after a title saying "three months later")
- 43 Mysterious beings named in Bible regarded variously as giants, fallen angels or visiting extraterrestrials in Bronze Age
- 44 Person from Troy such as Priam, Hector, Cassandra, Laocoön or Aeneas (from Greek)
- 45 *Das Rheingold* or Don Rickles (initials)
- 46 Kol Nidre or Kitten Natividad (initials)
- 47 State of continual change and uncertainty
- 48 Five-percenter, *Wu-Tang Clan* founder born Gary E. Grice AKA God Zig-Zag-Zig Allah in Supreme Alphabet of Clarence 13X AKA Allah the Father born Clarence Edward Smith
- 50 Maintain a neat and tidy personal appearance; train or prepare someone or something for a scheduled or foreseen event or occurrence often on internet
- 52 Frankie Machine or Fata Morgana (initials)
- 53 "Loneliness, is the ... you wear etc." *The Sun Ain't Gonna Shine Anymore* Walker Brothers
- 55 Old Testament prophet known as The Scribe known for mission to Jerusalem of 458 BCE to impose new racial supremacist code on polytheistic, integrated population of Canaan ("All the people wept when they heard the words of the Law")
- 56 Enemy, antagonist ("I was angry with my friend: I told my wrath, my wrath did end. I was angry with my ... I told it not, my wrath did grow" Blake)
- 57 Enigmatic contraction in Judaism of name of G-d to four letters by removing vowels
- 2 Town in south-west Victoria named after mountain in Turkey with notable residents Mr. Baldy, Gerald Ridsdale and George Pell (until successful High Court appeal)
- 3 Ancient Middle Eastern fertility deity with temples in Ashdod and Gaza (destroyed by Victor Mature in *Samson and Delilah*)
- 4 Kryal Castle (initials)
- 5 Atlantic, Jordan, gender, phobic (cf. cis)
- 6 German-born, American war criminal known for distinctive horn-rimmed glasses, voice and bombing Cambodia (5, 9)
- 7 Violent Basque separatist group known for striking hood with beret look (1, 1, 1)
- 8 Philadelphia experiment (initials)
- 9 Marvelous supermarket at 614 Sydney Rd., Brunswick
- 10 What was John Lennon in psychedelic *Beatles* classic (not walrus) (3, 3)
- 11 Red, Black, Yellow, Dead, scrotumtightening
