- 35 National Socialist *or* Norman Swain (initials)
- 37 Top selling US author (after Daniele Steele, Harold Robbins and Sidney Sheldon)
- 38 Dr. Sam Harris (initials)
- 39 Best known Australian poet (first name)
- 40 Software used to anonymously browse deep web
- 42 Baroque fountain associated with Nicola Salvi and Anita Ekberg
- 44 Iconic, Australian sheepskin boot named after imaginary caveman
- 46 Intriguing 1971 book by R. D. Laing
- 49 Displays of affection often given for free
- 50 Imagined, envisioned, conceived, pictured
- 51 Controversial top selling English author (after Shakespeare, Agatha Christie and Barbara Cartland) (first name)
- 52 Islands off west coast of Ireland associated with Robert Flaherty and distinctive knitwear
- 58 Idle, feckless, disreputable person (often in relation to refusal to pay child support)
- 59 Shirley MacLaine role in excruciating 1963 Billy Wilder comedy with Jack Lemmon as lovable Parisian gendarme
- 60 Dalet, Morgenthau, *9 from Outer Space*
- 61 Jaunty, brimmed felt hat with little feather
- 63 *Dirección de Inteligencia Nacional* (initials)
- 67 Priestess of Aphrodite in tragic myth about death by drowning of ardent lover Leander in Hellespont
- 69 Expected at or planned for a certain time such as an assignment, library book or baby
- 71 Hittite general sent to certain death in battle by King David out of lust for wife Bathsheba (Susan Haywood in 1951 epic movie)
- 72 Region of France in surreal exchange in *Waiting for Godot* (“No, I was never in the ... country. I’ve puked my puke of a life away here. I tell you. Here! In the Cackon country!”)
- 73 Ancient kingdom in south Pacific comprising archipelago of 169 islands mostly uninhabited
- 74 Space time continuum (initials)
- 75 Evil, unhealthy air
- 79 US territory in Western Pacific with no birds due to devastating impact of introduced snakes
