- 1 "Up the close and doon the stair / But and ben' wi' Burke and ... / Burke's the butcher, ... 's the thief / Knox the boy that buys the beef" Shiftless Irishman at centre of scandal involving provision of cadavers for medical dissection in 19th century Edinburgh ending in exoneration of procurer Knox, adoption of "Burke" and "Burkism" as terms for murder (by strangulation) and public execution of Willian Burke attended by crowd of 25,000 yelling, "Burke him! Burke him!" in macabre display of ethos of the day
- 5 Old
- 6 ... *VoVo* Popular wheat flour biscuit topped with pink fondant flanking strip of raspberry jam and sprinkled with coconut associated with former Prime Minister Kevin Rudd

- 1 Exclamation conveying profound deference (Caesar, Mary etc.)
- 2 Disturbed, would-be 1981 assassin of Pope John Paul II stating on release in Jan 2006, "In the name of God Almighty, I proclaim the end of the world in this century. All the world will be destroyed. Every human being will die. I am not God, I am not son of God, I am Christ eternal" (also expressing desire to enter Roman Catholic priesthood and coauthor book with Dan Brown)
- 3 Name shared by authors of controversial texts *Heroin* and *The Controversy of Zion*4 Greatly loved US singer (*Indian Love Call, Sweet Mystery of Life* etc.)

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
