14 Role played by Bernhard Goetzke in early, silent Fritz Lang film of 1921 Der Müde Tod (The Tired Death)
15 Cover or envelop to conceal from view
18 Inscrutable Bond villain with no hands
19 Sigmund Freud or Samantha Fox (initials)
21 Long strands of hair worn by Orthodox Jewish males observing prohibition revealed on Sinai of "rounding the corners of your head" $(3,5)$

25 Algerian resistance group committed to expulsion of colonial invader by any means in 1950s (as depicted in marvelous 1966 Pontecorvo movie banned in France)

28 Object encased in bundle of bound rods in symbol of state power (of Etruscan origin) associated with fascism

30 Wittily named parrot of Dorothy Parker 32 US graphic designer known for iconic film title sequences (The Man with Golden Arm, Anatomy of a Murder, Seconds etc.) (4, 4) (7 down, 32 across)
34 Portmanteau term for uniquely American phenomenon of vociferous religious fanatic on TV (affirming prescient observation of Alexis De Tocqueville in 1830s: "Religious insanity is common in the United States")
36 Electric chair or Eric Cartman (initials)
37 Hebrew for "God hath numbered thy kingdom and finished it" (in ripping Bible story about ghostly writing on wall at feast)
38 Bengt Ekerot or Billie Eilish (initials)
39 EDM sub-genre associated with Goa and transcendent absorption in Brahman through annihilation of self in pounding rhythm
42 Predecessor to CIA associated with espionage, dangerous missions behind enemy lines, ingenious gadgetry and Diana Prince (AKA Wonder Woman) (in 40s)
44 Invention transforming war (in 40s)
45 Initials shared by celebrated authors of disparate texts Utopia and Jump in my Car

2 Eerie call of great horned owl

5 Valley outside Jerusalem associated with child sacrifice to Yahweh (in early years)
6 Miraculous journey made in one night by Prophet Muhammed (PBUH) from Makkah to Masjid al-Aqsa, in Jerusalem on heavenly horse Lightning in ripping story in Surah 17
$7 \quad$ Biblical king rejected by G-d for sparing King Agag thus defying order to kill all Amalekites ("both man and woman, infant and suckling, ox and sheep, camel and ass") in ripping Bible story (rebuked by High Priest Samuel who hacked Agag in pieces before the Lord showing what true obedience looks like)
8 Ernst Röhm or Easy Rider (initials)
9 James Dean role (not Cal Trask or Jim Stark)
10 Ostentatious style of marching associated with fascism

12 12 Racial supremacism (initials)
Popular colour from 60s associated with aviator sunglasses of Hunter S. Thomson an followers of disgraced guru Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh (in 80s) Cafe Kebab King, 348 High St, Northcote

Majority branch of Islam preponderant Saudi Arabia, Indonesia, Gaza etc.
45 Absolute monarch of Russia (before murder by Bolsheviks in Yekaterinburg in 1917)
47 Prescient German author (Jud Süß etc.) (unusual first name)
49 Derisive term for person of wealth or high social standing (chiefly UK)
