- 1 Islamic endowment charged with immutable custodianship of significant Muslim site such Al-Aqsa Mosque in occupied Palestine
- 5 "I'm a Barbie girl, in the Barbie world / Life in plastic, it's fantastic" Danish/Norwegian Europop group known for multi-platinum hit Barbie Girl (in 90s)
- 6 Hereditary ruler murdered (with wife and children) on 17<sup>th</sup> July 1918 in Yekaterinburg (renamed Sverdlovsk in 1924 after Bolshevik leader who relayed order) (from Lenin)
- 7 Greatly loved Palestinian intellectual known for seminal text *Orientalism*, concept of post-colonialism and heated debates with English neocon, Islamophobe, apologist for state terror and moral monster Bernard Lewis 4 (in 00s)

- 1 Large, ornate Buddhist temples particularly in Cambodia, Laos and Thailand
- Third holiest site of Islam (after Makkah and Medina) referred to as "the farthest mosque" in Sura recounting magical journey (in one night) of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) on heavenly creature "Lightning" to occupied East Jerusalem
- 3 Les ... des Brumes Seminal poetic film noir of 1938 by Marcel Carné and Jacques Prévert with Jean Gabin as doomed army deserter hero, Michèle Morgan as raincoated runaway, Michel Simon as abusive guardian and Pierre Brasseur as the gangster Lucien) (also known as Port of Shadows)
- 4 Mandatory; required; of acts of religious observance which Muslims must perform (if physically able) such as prayer and Hajj (also controversial Nation of Islam founder prior to mysterious disappearance in 1934)

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
