- 1** Troubled co-founder of *Public Enemy* (with Chuck D) in 80s known for signature clock signifying enigmatically that “time is the most important element, and when we stop, time keeps going” (6, 4)
- 11** “I met her in a club down in old Soho / Where you drink champagne and it tastes just like Coca-Cola (C-O-L-A, Cola) / She walked up to met and she asked me to dance / I asked her her name and in a dark brown voice she said ...” *Kinks* classic
- 12** Iconic *Marshall* guitar amp seminal in 60s rock (Jimi Hendrix, *Cream*, *The Who* etc.) known for incredible volume and crunchy overdrive
- 13** Invasion Day or Izzy Dy (initials)
- 14** German heavy metal legend performing at *The Croc* at 607 High St., Thornbury tonight (initials)
- 16** Preloved
- 17** Mood associated with 36 across
- 19** Marvelous mannerist painter from Venice (*Finding of the Body of Saint Mark*, *Miracle of the Slave* etc.) nicknamed *Il Furioso* due to speed of execution
- 23** Hated political leader associated with fossil fuel and *Robodebt* (first name)
- 24** Manifest Destiny or Mort Drucker or Mr. Darcy (initials)
- 25** Unpleasant kind of milk associated with air travel
- 26** Alternative Melbourne rock band known for edgy titles such as *Australia the Lucky* \*\*\*\* re-released as *Censored Due to Legal Advice* following legal action taken by Ken Done for unauthorized use of koala image (with syringe) on cover etc.
- 28** *Eight Elvises* or Eazy-E (initials)
- 30** *Reclaim Australia* or Rick Astley (initials)
- 31** *Frankie ... Suicide* classic
- 34** *Cum On Feel the ... Slade* classic
- 36** Person from Nordic kingdom on Baltic Sea (Søren Kierkegaard, Carl Dreyer, Lars Von Trier, Mads Mikkelsen, Hamlet etc.)
- 37** Subjected to severe criticism or denunciation (9-11 Noam Chomsky, *Warnunge D. Martini Luther an seine lieben Deutschen* etc.)

- 1** Famous prehistoric man (not habilis, erectus, or neanderthalensis)
- 2** Israeli city of ancient origin known for martyrdom of Saint George in 4<sup>th</sup> century, ethnic cleansing in 1948 and airport
- 3** Arab League or Albert Langer (initials)
- 4** Modernist sculpture removed from location in central Melbourne following display of aesthetic outrage by local citizenry (widely known as *The Yellow Peril*) (and *Steelhenge*) (humourless official title please)
- 5** Red pill or Roman Polanski or restorative proctocolectomy (initials)

- 6** Celebrated music producer associated with “future bass” genre (not Hudson Mohawke, Rustie, Lido, San Holo or Cashmere Cat)
- 7** *Enfants du Paradis*, *Misérables*, *Diaboliques*, *Brown and his Band of Renown* etc.
- 8** Implement of ancient origin thrown in new recreational craze at *Maniax* 121 Elizabeth Street, Melbourne (and 19-21 Russell St, Abbotsford) also *Valhalla* “Smash the Doors of Heaven” cnr. Cameron and Peveril Streets Brunswick)
- 10** Recorded using antiquated technology of 80s
- 15** Condemn to death, destruction or some other terrible fate
- 17** Member of enigmatic 1<sup>st</sup> century religious sect associated with intriguing, non-canonical gospels of Judas, Mary and Thomas (“The kingdom of the father is spread upon the earth but men do not see it” etc.) discovered in Nag Hammadi, Egypt in 1945
- 18** Alphabetical, Holy, on-line, Hitler, *New* etc.
- 20** UK chemical giant with office in pioneering, 19-storey, International Style skyscraper at 1 Nicholson Street, East Melbourne (in 50s)
- 21** *The Undead* (initials)
- 22** Ornate seat of monarch symbolizing power made from precious materials such as gold and unicorn horn
- 27** Enigmatic masked student (with six webbed arms) at My Hero Academia High School known for mysterious, undisclosed pain in past (in popular superhero manga series)
- 29** 13<sup>th</sup> century compendium of Norse mythology compiled by Snorri Sturluson (also daughter of Hermann Göring born in 1938 and called by English journalist Douglas Reed as “a sort of Nazi crown princess”)
- 32** Rectangular, tasseled veil used in Eastern church (following Byzantine rite) to cover Chalice and Diskos (whilst on Prothesis) (from Greek for air due to lightness)
- 33** “No, no, no life. Why should a dog, a horse, a ... have life, /And thou no breath at all?” *King Lear*
- 35** Castrated bovid sacrificed in large numbers at ancient hecatomb
