- 23** Insane Austrian psychoanalyst known for orgone accumulator and bizarre cloudbusting machine as seen in Kate Bush video
- 25** Drunken, lascivious mythological creature depicted in arresting ithyphallic tableaux on Greek pottery
- 26** Giving to people in need (in eastern religion) as an expression of compassion with no desire for reward to transform the mind by reducing the acquisitive impulse which leads to continued attachment, egotism and suffering
- 27** A strong, restless desire to do something despite foreseeable dire consequences
- 28** Haille Selassie or Harry Styles (initials)
- 29** Highly anticipated pick for running mate in 2024 US presidential election raising concerns about antisemitism in Democratic Party (initials)
- 30** Langston Hughes or Lang Hancock or Lionel Hardcastle or Lovey Howell (initials)
- 31** "Ho Ho ... Chi Minh!" Rousing chant from anti-war rallies in 60s
- 32** Small, ornamental sewing case for needles etc.
- 34** Delicious salad invented in Mexico by Cesar Gardini in 20s
- 36** Brightly coloured plastic building blocks in worldwide mania
- 38** Seminal UK post-punk band (*This is not a Love Song* etc.)

- 1** US poet, musician, co-founder of seminal punk band *Television* fired for distracting jumping around during songs leading to formation of *The Voidoids* with Robert Quine and Marc Bell (later Marky Ramone) and 1977 release *Blank Generation* (Rimbaud inspired stage name) (7, 4)
- 2** Light greyish-yellowish brown such as seen in a jumper from *A.P.C.* or *Muji*
- 3** Obscuring the meaning of a communication by making it hard to understand usually with vague, confusing or jargonistic terminology such as "The NFSP under my stewardship believed fundamentally that Horizon was a robust system without any systemic fault issues" or making the scaffolding resilient
- 4** Brandenburg, Golden, Ishtar, *Heaven's* etc.
- 5** Iconic Barbara Feldman role in 60s (initials)
- 6** "And I'll shrink a couple inches / I'll lose a few more stone / If you would promise me / That you will never leave me alone" Heartrending, modern indie classic by Manchester-based Westislonely
- 7** Inge King or Illya Kuryakin or Isla Koch or Isaac Kook (initials)
- 8** Clumsy, oafish person (UK)
- 9** Hidden, ill-defined area of illicit activity, seedy underbelly, nebulous realm inhabited by wandering souls of dead etc.

- 15** Popular dinner of ancient origin (5, 4)
- 18** North Melbourne or Norman Mailer (initials)
- 19** *Shalom in the Home* (initials)

- 31** American tribal love-rock musical (from 60s)
