- 1** Tetragrammaton
- 5** Boundary between earth's crust and mantle with depths varying from 3 miles under ocean floor to 25 miles beneath continents named after Croatian seismologist who detected it in 1909
- 6** Volume of poetry by Ted Hughes published in 1970 acclaimed as finest work ending dry spell in 60s after killing wife
- 7** Neat and tidy to an all-consuming, neurotic degree from Freudian stages of psychosexual development (not oral, phallic, Oedipal, latency or genital) (also dreaded probe associated with alien abduction in 70s)

- 1** "No man / does it all by himself / I said / young man / put your pride on the shelf etc." *Village People* anthem with touching vision of human frailty, compassion and solidarity
- 2** Large peninsula in East Africa comprising Somalia, Djibouti, Ethiopia and Eritrea extending into Indian Ocean beneath the Gulf of Aden
- 3** Traditional way to make a horse stop
