- 1 Address on Sunset Strip of detective agency of “Stu” Bailey (Efrem Zimbalist Jr.) in 60s TV show known for infectious Mack David theme and comedy relief supplied by rock ‘n’ roll-loving, wisecracking, hair-combing hepcat Gerald “Kookie” Kookson III, aspiring PI and valet parking attendant at Dean Martin’s club *Dino’s Lodge* next door
- 12 Beautiful Japanese city known for temples, palaces and cherry blossoms
- 13 What kind of man was Esau in baffling Bible story about deception of Isaac by younger son Jacob to obtain blessing of aged father? (1, 5)
- 14 Poem by Dante describing final part of epic journey encountering Empyrean
- 15 *Ash* ... (US art school) *can-...* (lewd dance)
- 16 Sing a melody softly with closed lips such as in *Crash Test Dummies* classic *Mmm Mmm Mmm Mmm* or sublime *Beach Boys* song (“Surf’s up mm mm mm mm mm mm aboard a tidal wave etc.”)
- 17 “Beam me up, ...” Dour, cantankerous chief engineer of USS Enterprise in *Star Trek*
- 18 Be vividly expressive of something; exude
- 20 “..., meeny, miney, moe, catch a etc.”
- 23 Norman Rockwell (initials)
- 24 Behaving in a wild, hysterical, unhinged, disruptive, destructive, uncontrollable manner
- 27 Coarse *Rolling Stones* song (from 60s)
- 29 Discrete historical period with distinguishable character (Byzantine, Carolingian, punk etc.)
- 30 Premises serving as the managerial and administrative centre of an organization
- 36 Popular skateboarding manoeuvre in which rider and board leap into air over stationary objects performed by coarse hooligans in public places
- 37 Poetic works written as celebration of something such as a Grecian urn, Cromwell’s return from crushing Irish or Billy Joe MacAllister jumping off Tallahatchie bridge
- 38 Pioneering American humourist (*Gentlemen Prefer Blondes* etc.) and visionary Austrian architect known for despicable private life
- 39 Fifth pillar of Islamic practice requiring pilgrimage to Makkah and circumambulation of Kaaba (fard if physically possible) (beginning next Wednesday until Monday 9<sup>th</sup>)

- 42 Greek term occurring once in the Bible indicating the stone on which Jesus stood “in the place that is called ... and in Hebrew, Gabbatha” (John 19) where Pilate on the “judgment seat” condemned him to death incorporated in early Muslim era into the Dome of the Rock (*Qubbat al-Sakhrah*) due to the tradition that the footprints of Jesus could be seen in it)

- 1 German dissident and *Weißer Rose* co-founder guillotined (with brother Hans) for treason in 1943 with touching last words “Die Sonne scheint noch” (6, 6)
- 2 Hirsute first-born son of Isaac who traded birthright to wily younger brother Jacob in baffling Bible story celebrating deceitful origins of House of Israel
- 3 US colloquialism (chiefly southwest) for creatures regarded as vermin and pejorative associated with Yosemite Sam
- 4 One (Sanskrit)
- 5 Lowest point, rock bottom (*Eyes Wide Shut*, *Ryan’s Daughter*, *Scary Movie 5* etc.)
- 6 Greatly loved Palestinian leader known by kunya Abu Ammar or “The Old Man” may the souls of the martyrs rest in perfect peace (6, 6)
- 7 Sudden surprising or upsetting experience
- 8 Elias Ashmole or *Easy Rider* (initials)
- 9 Singled out for cruel, unjust, discriminatory treatment
- 10 He/she/it was (“quod ... demonstrandum”, “In principio ... Latin verbum” etc.) (Latin)
- 11 “I ain’t even legal, I don’t wanna die young” Teen rapper from Vallejo, California known for touching paean to black youth set in *Arco* gas station (feat. Daboi)
- 19 Catchy 2016 hit by Marseille rapper Soprano “Comme Zinedine Zidane face à l’équipe du Brésil / J’suis en feu / Ce soir tout me sourit même Monica Bellucci / J’suis en feu (j’suis chaud, j’suis chaud, j’suis chaud) etc.” (2, 3)
- 21 “A Man Went Looking for America... and Couldn’t Find it Anywhere” 1969 counterculture classic known for motorbikes, annoying hippies and uplifting *Steppenwolf* soundtrack (initials)
- 22 Pertaining to language and culture of Ashkenazi Jewry in medieval Europe (lox, gefilte fish etc.)
- 24 Alan Turing (initials)
- 25 Oval Office (initials)
- 26 Ancient city associated with bull-jumping, snake goddess, Linear B and inaccurate and irreversible reconstructions of architectural remains by archeological fabulist Arthur Evans
- 28 “Jump in my ... I want to take you home etc.” Ted Mulray classic from 1974 with 2006 David Hasselhoff version voted runner up in MAX Music’s World’s Worst Ever Video (for 2008)
- 31 Torpid, morally vacant, post-human race bred as food source by bestial, subterranean Morlocks in dystopian vision of endpoint of English class system in *The Time Machine* by H. G. Wells (in 802,701 CE)
- 32 A great amount; to a large extent etc. (1, 3)
- 33 Queen Esther (initials)
- 34 Supreme Japanese commander executed as Class-A war criminal in 1948 being found guilty of charges inc. waging wars of aggression, war in violation of international law, unprovoked war and inhumane treatment of civilians and POWs through forced labour, massacre, starvation etc.
- 35 Quickie divorce capital in Nevada
- 39 Hate site (initials)
- 40 Ruthless, Texan oil baron shot under mysterious circumstance in 70s
