3 Sadly missed, paleo-conservative, libertarian *Antiwar.com* founder (1951-2019)
4 Legendarily cruel slave master in *Uncle Tom’s Cabin*
5 “I hear / my ...-spirit sob in each blood cell, as if my hand were at its throat / I myself am hell blah blah blah” Lowell
6 What was “Rosebud” in *Citizen Kane* (revealed in dramatic finale in unforgettable image of unknowableness of truth)
