- 1** Apocryphal Australian town denoting extreme remoteness (4, 4)
- 2** Excrement, waste, filth, dung
- 3** Character in Victorian Department of Education early reader *John and Betty* (1951) with male and female stereotypes playing with truck and dog and pram and cat respectively
- 4** Head-covering of white linen draped around the neck and chin and covering the top of the head sometimes elaborately starched, creased or folded or supported by wicker framing for extra height worn by women in Medieval Europe
- 5** "Isn't the moonlight terrible" Pulitzer Prize winning play of 1938 by Thornton Wilder (with 1940 film version with William Holden and marvelous score by Aaron Copland) (initials)
- 6** Brazilian architect of nightmarish modernist capital Brasília (initials)
- 7** "Da da da dum / da da da dum / da da da / da da da / da da da dum etc." Beethoven symphony with famous start
- 11** Turgid, 60s English remake of poetic, French, 30s masterwork by Jean Vigo
- 13** Umberto Eco *or* "Uli" Edel (initials)
