- 10** Mountain range of northern Morocco
- 11** Deities in Greek mythology personifying destiny responsible for spinning (Clotho), allotting (Lachesis) and ending (Atropos) life
- 12** Existential threat (initials)
- 13** *Viet ...* Resistance organization committed to expulsion of foreign aggressor and liberation of country by any means (successful)
- 14** Leonard Teale *or* Larry Tate *or* László Toth (initials)
- 15** What was Billy Ray Cyrus's heart in catchy hit from 90s (not breaky)
- 17** Final installment with *Flesh* (1968) and *Trash* (1972) of nihilistic Andy Warhol trilogy with Joe Dellasandro as dissolute lead character, Joe
- 19** Life-changing choice between knowledge and ignorance made by Neo in *The Matrix* (3, 3, 4)
- 21** National treasure (not Cate) (or Nick)
- 22** English PM who resigned in disgrace after colluding with France and Israel in plot to unseat Nasser, gain control of control Suez Canal and reassert British relevance on post-war world stage (unsuccessful) (initials)
- 23** Large, insistent, annoying insect associated with Australian bush
- 26** Precious stone known for hypnotic fluro colours

- 28** Adopting style or accoutrements of previous era for startling or ironic effect such as Nokia Flip or mullet
- 30** Wandering, lordless samurai (Sanjuro, Zatoichi, Loan Wolf and cub etc.)
- 32** Bliss cf. *dukh* (suffering) (Sanskrit) (also Pali)
- 33** Famous "texts" from ancient Egypt consisting of shards of unfired clay inscribed with names of enemies and broken into pieces ensuring victory in battle

- 1** Nightmarish entity described in *Revelation* 17 riding a seven-headed beast, decked with gold, precious stones and pearls and with a golden cup full of the abominations and filthiness of her fornication signifying Rome (5, 5)
- 2** Letter denoted in sinister "88" skinhead tattoo (also popular, Nazi-era witticism "Himmler's brain is called Heydrich") (also UK rapper from Manchester with touching song *My G* about little sister) (feat. Ed Sheeran)
- 3** Noel Ferrier *or* Norman Finkelstein (initials)
- 4** Music genre (*Dashboard Confessional*, *Sunny Day Real Estate*, *Cap'n Jazz*, *Moose Blood* etc.) with sub-genre *Screamo* (*I Hate Myself* etc.)
- 5** Silent-era horror star (*Phantom of the Opera*, *The Hunchback of Notre Dame*, *He Who Gets Slapped*) with horror actor son (*The Wolfman*) (also caveman father of Victor Mature in *One Million B.C.*) (first name)

- 6** Religious office descending from Aaron inc. Eli, Zadock or Caiaphas (played by Mattia Sbragia in Mel Gibson's *Passion of the Christ* with controversial scene after Crucifixion depicting belated, agonized realization of what he has done) (4, 6)
- 7** Controversial authors (*The Fountainhead*, *Atlas Shrugged*, *Der Mythus des zwanzigsten Jahrhunderts*) (initials)
- 8** Onomatopoeia for light-hearted, carefree singing (2-2-2)
- 9** Affable giant of English folklore associated with Alan Hale (6, 4)
- 13** Алфавит, используемый для письма на русском, болгарском, сербском, украинском и других славянских языках
- 16** Poisonous psychotropic plant associated with murder of Hamlet's father (by pouring in ear) and legendary frenzy in battle of Berserkers
- 18** Eretz Israel *or* Electronic Intifada (initials)
- 20** Bolognese semiotics professor known for mediaeval crime fiction bestseller in 80s
- 24** Austrian psychoanalyst associated with orgone accumulator, cloud busting and controversial 1971 Dušan Makavejev arthouse biopic subtitle *Mysteries of the Organism* banned for obscenity and "derision of the state" in former Yugoslavia (initials)
- 25** Ornately decorated case for needles, thread, tiny scissors and other useful items
- 27** Deadly disease symbolic of moral decline indicated in art of William Hogarth by sinister black spots on faces of afflicted (also colourful Australianism of uncertain origin "dressed up like a ... doctor's clerk")
- 29** Legendary American film studio (*Citizen Kane*, *The Conqueror*, *I Walked with a Zombie* etc.)
- 31** Nuremberg Rally *or* Norman Rockwell *or* Nicholas Ray *or* Nile Rogers (initials)
