Mysterious oracular object (אֹרִיִּים “lights”) with thummim (תְּמִיִּם “truth”) adorning the hoshen (breastplate) attached to the ephod (apron) of Israelite High Priests for guidance on matters of national importance with letters lighting up miraculously revealing divine will

Pharaoh of Egypt (c.1290-1279 BCE) in 19th dynasty preceded by father Ramesses I and followed by son Ramesses II (The Great) with reign noted for ongoing conflict with Hittites, reassertion of sovereignty over Canaan (after territorial losses due to religious reforms of Akhenaten) and Exodus (c.1290BC) (alleged)

Leader of centaurs from Forbidden Forest in story about new fifth-year Hogwarts student Poppy Sweeting (in 1890-91 school year) and quest to rescue endangered Golden Snidgets from poachers in *Hogwarts Legacy*
