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### Across

2 Sam Harris or Shemp Howard or Sid Halen or Saddam Hussein (initials)

3 Effective ADHD medication

4 Acclaimed singer from Mullumbimby (first name with middle initial)

5 Iconic John Travolta role (not Tony Manero, Vinnie Barbarino, Danny Zuko, Billy Nolan, Edna Turnblad or Vincent Vega) (CLUE: Merciless Chief of Security assigned to rule Earth One after conquest by Psychlo Empire in 31<sup>st</sup> century in controversial screen adaptation of L. Ron Hubbard novel)

6 Famous member of Vienna Kriminalpolizei homicide unit (as seen on SBS in 90s) (initials)

7 Beginning, burgeoning, showing promise

11 Irish murderer granted immunity for testimony against fellow "resurrectionist" William Burke in notorious, 1827 trial in Edinburgh resulting in conviction and public hanging attended by crowd of twenty-five thousand people yelling, "Burke him! Burke him!" in neologism of day
