- 13** Famous movie character from 60s known for having baby of the Devil and pixie cut
- 15** Initials shared by authors of disparate texts *Triumph of the Will* and *Heroin* (also *Good Golly, Miss Molly*) (and *Hello*) (and *The Kiss of Death: Memoirs of a Sporting Legend*)
- 16** Boiled bread product of eastern European origin (delicious with cream cheese and lox)
- 17** Angel depicted blowing trumpet on spire of Salt Lake Temple, Utah who revealed whereabouts of golden plates containing book of Mormon to prophet Joseph Smith in upstate New York in 1823 during era of religious fervour called the Second Great Awakening (presumed to still have them having been returned after translation)
- 18** Australian personality known for far right views and pumpkin scones (first name)
- 20** Charles Napier (initials)
- 21** Alarming new T-shirt (chiefly US) (4, 4)

- 2** Protective suit of metal worn by knights in Middle Ages and Hitler in *Der Bannerträger* (*The Standard Bearer*) inspirational portrait by Hubert Lanzinger of 1935 (US spelling)
- 3** Days in middle of month (with full moon) when Julius Caesar was killed
- 4** German battleship sunk in North Atlantic by *HMS King George V* and *HMS Rodney* (commanded by Capt. Frederick Dalrymple-Hamilton) with support of *HMS Ark Royal* and *Force H* in ripping naval battle of 1941 (named after Prussian statesman)
- 5** Castrated bovid sacrificed in large numbers at hecatomb (and temple of Solomon)
- 6** Labyrinthine home of rabbits
- 9** Term designating anchorite ascetic practicing mortification of the flesh by living on top of a column such as Simeon (c. 390?-459 CE) of Aleppo
- 10** Mad doctor played by Howard Vernon in 1962 horror film by prolific Spanish director Jesús Franco (*Vampyros Lesbos* etc.)
- 11** Mountain in Jordan from which Moses was permitted to view Holy Land (being forbidden to enter due to earlier misunderstanding at rock of Kadesh in wilderness of Zin)
