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| <p><b>1</b> Metaphorical final opportunity for decisive action to avert impending disaster (8, 4)</p> <p><b>2</b> Imagined; chimerical; having no existence such as the self in Buddhism</p> <p><b>3</b> Pejorative term for gentile (from Hebrew for nation but with negative connotation since definition of Maimonides in 12<sup>th</sup> century as “a worshipper of idolatry”)</p> <p><b>4</b> Hitler Youth (initials)</p> <p><b>5</b> <i>The Dead</i> (initials)</p> <p><b>6</b> Book of Bible produced by exilic Levites in Babylon about sadness and desolation after destruction of Temple by Nebuchadnezzar in 586 BCE (read on Tisha B’Av regarded as the saddest day in the Jewish calendar)</p> <p><b>7</b> <i>Popol ...</i> 60s Krautrock band with Florian Fricke named after Mayan myth cycle known for haunting film music (<i>Aguirre, the Wrath of God</i> etc.)</p> <p><b>8</b> Leading American Billy Idol Live Experience tribute band (4, 1)</p> <p><b>9</b> Sita is the answer (initial)</p> <p><b>10</b> Young German dissident tried for treason and guillotined as an enemy of the state in 1943 (6, 6)</p> | <p><b>14</b> Drive, force or urge someone to do something</p> <p><b>15</b> Town in North Yorkshire with prominent nab (with lookout tower built for early warning of Napoleonic invasion)</p> <p><b>17</b> Someone or thing which foreshadows a future event or comes first to herald the approach of another</p> <p><b>21</b> Popular Australian TV show associated with Tina Arena and Jamie Redfern (initials)</p> <p><b>25</b> Colour</p> <p><b>26</b> Hardline Egyptian leader (first name) (not Gamal, Anwar, Mohamed or Abdel Fattah)</p> <p><b>28</b> Catch, ensnare, entangle</p> <p><b>29</b> “... bin ein Berliner” (“I am a donut”) JFK</p> <p><b>34</b> Third son of Adam given by G-d in place of Abel with purported tomb in Beit Shit, Israel</p> <p><b>35</b> US mail-order manufacturing company associated with Wile E.
