- 1** Philosophy of political pragmatism associated with Sun Tzu, Otto von Bismarck and Henry Kissinger
- 8** Celebrated Wagnerian conductor known for funereal tempi and TV star brother (initials)
- 9** Lola Lola or Lisa Lopes (initials)
- 10** Historical term widely used for fateful offer from Kaiser Wilhelm II to Austria-Hungary of unconditional support for any action taken against Serbia in retaliation for assassination of Archduke (leading to war in 1914) (5, 6)
- 14** Italian composer of marvelous film music (*Spasmo, The Thing, Butterfly, Casualties of War* etc., etc.) (initials)
- 15** United Ireland (initials)
- 16** United Australia Party (initials)
- 17** One who believes in innate and immutable superiority conferred by ethnicity
- 21** Last pope (d. 1958) recognized as legitimate incumbent by Sedevacantist Catholics despite widespread condemnation for "silence" during WW2
- 22** French American writer known for racy diary and torrid affair with Henry Miller in 40s (also Otto Rank) (1, 3) (with first initial)
- 23** Belief in immutable entitlement to territories occupied by earlier generations and their reclamation by force (Tibet, Palestine, Golan Heights, Shebaa Farms etc., etc., etc.)
- 26** *Endless Night* (initials)
- 27** Vast, mountainous, pre-Columbian empire without writing or wheel
- 28** Inhabitant of beautiful island in eastern Mediterranean known for colossal statue of Helios (destroyed by earthquake 230 BCE)
- 31** Incalculably long period of time
- 32** Ethiopian aristocratic title associated with Tafari Makonnen (AKA Haile Selassie I)
- 33** Troubled US child actress, model and author (*C'mon, Get Happy - Fear and Loathing on the Partridge Family Bus*) (with first initial) (1, 3)
- 35** United Israel (initials)
- 36** Select group (in hardline Calvinist cosmology) predestined (from before Creation) to be saved all else being damned to eternity in Hell
- 37** "When I'm in your neighborhood, you better duck / Coz Ice Cube is crazy as **** / As I leave, believe I'm stompin' / But when I come back, boy, I'm comin' straight ... Compton" *Straight ... Compton*

- 1** Leading figure of French Revolution known for role in *Comité de salut public, la Terreur* and proposal to replace Roman Catholicism as national religion of France with deistic *Culte de l'Être supreme* (executed 1794)

- 3** Evil machine historically associated with New South Wales (and Jaimie Packer)
- 4** Famous role of German actor Otto Wernicke (memorable for arresting shot seated on chair from extreme low angle signifying power)
- 5** *I LIKE* ... American Cold War president with catchy campaign slogan
- 6** Mixed up Theban king killed unwittingly by son on crossroads in Greek myth about two worst things you could possibly do
- 7** Condition characterized by inability to resist recurring impulse to steal
- 11** Leading figure in Auckland black/death/doom metal scene (*Diocletian, Streetkunt* etc.) (aka Logan Muir III and Bogan) (with first initial) (1, 4)
- 12** Profession associated with Hattie Jacques, Mildred Ratched and Florence Nightingale
- 13** Compound made from bark of cinchona tree used for malaria medication and tonic water (also painful leg cramps at night)
- 18** The reason for which something is done or was created or exists
- 19** Mythological female attendant of Dionysus known for orgiastic dancing in faun skins holding thyrsus of giant fennel and ivy with a pine cone on the end
- 20** Global financial giant based in New York
- 24** One who believes in a non-interventionist creator deity who, having instituted laws of physical universe doesn't care what happens in it, require worship, respond to prayer or need a self-appointed priesthood to tell people what it wants them to do because it doesn't want anything
- 25** Greatly loved character from US literature (played by Mary Badham in acclaimed 1962 movie version of American classic) (with Gregory Peck in Oscar-winning lead)
