- 1 Greatly loved US musician (*The Ballad of Jed Clampett*) (with Lester Flatt)
- 2 Metrical foot (in poetry) consisting of an unstressed syllable followed by a stressed syllable (“For I have sworn thee fair and thought thee bright, Who art as black as hell, as dark as night”)
- 3 Curtis Jackson *or* Cleopatra Jones (initials)
- 4 Universally lauded director of leaden art films
- 5 Celebrated UK musician known for iconic Windows start up sound expressing infinite promise of new day
- 6 Priam, Hecuba, Paris, Hector, Cassandra, Laocoön, Aeneas etc.
- 10 Unrepentant leader of Apartheid-era South Africa known as “Die Groote Krokodil” convicted of crimes against humanity by Truth and Reconciliation Council led by Archbishop Tutu (rescinded) and offered a state funeral in spirit of magnanimity by Thabo Mbeki government in 2006 (declined)
- 12 Initials shared by authors of provocative texts *Guide to Kulchur*, hardline, anti-immigration “rivers of blood” speech (quoting Virgil) in UK parliament in 1968 and *In the Ghetto*
- 15 Goddess in Greek mythology personifying dawn associated with epithet *ροδοδάκτυλος* (“rosy-fingered”) in Homer
- 17 Celebrated authors of disparate texts *Being and Time* and *The Sound of White* (initials)
