- 1** Hard-bitten NYPD police lieutenant (in 70s)
- 6** Angel (Hebrew אֱלֹהִים “El/G-d is my light”) with fiery sword placed at entrance of garden of Eden to keep mankind out (after Fall)
- 7** Celebrated German writer best known for autobiographical novella about riven hero on holiday in Venice (with first initial) (1, 4)
- 10** “... the Priest and Nathan the Prophet anointed Solomon King. And all the people rejoiced, and said: God save the King! Long live the King!” Passage from 1 Kings in Coronation anthem of G. F. Handel used in England since 1727 (notable for remaining unchanged in coronation of female monarchs because the king referred to is Solomon)

- 1** “The horror, the horror” Insane ivory trader in seminal 1898 novella by Joseph Conrad also cool, rogue Green Beret colonel in 1979 counterculture classic (“I watched a snail crawl along the edge of a straight razor. This is my dream; this is my nightmare. Crawling, slithering, along the edge of a straight razor, and surviving” etc.)
- 2** Orange revolution *or* Oral Roberts (initials)
- 3** *mAbu* ... Touching kunya used by the martyr Khalil al-Wazir (1935-88) signifying role as “father of the struggle” رحمه الله ارواح الشهداء
- 4** Anthony Eden *or* Albert Ellis *or* Augustus Egg (initials)
- 5** Famous Nazi prison camp commandant
- 8** Michelangelo Antonioni *or* Mohammed Atta *or* Martin Amis *or* Madeleine “we think the price was worth it” Albright (initials)
- 9** Famous work by lauded Soviet-era poet and milquetoast dissident Yevgeny Yevtushenko город да город нет (literally *Town Yes Town* ...)
