- 1 Vibrant Indian city besmirched in West by Malcolm Muggeridge and Mother Teresa as godless, poverty-stricken, disease-ridden, heathen hellhole (name since 2001)
- 7 Californian DJ, electronic music producer and *Witch House* pioneer Christopher Dexter Greenspan (*NoSummr4U*, *Good Songs for Bad People* with *Islamiq Grrrls* called “ethereal stoner witch-pop” etc.) (cool stage name)
- 8 Disturbed US child star (*The Parent Trap*, *Herbie: Fully loaded*, *Scary Movie V* etc.) (cool street name)
- 9 Capital of Malaysia (cool nickname)
- 10 16<sup>th</sup> century Florentine goldsmith known for famous salt cellar with mythological figures signifying land and sea and classical temple (for pepper)
- 11 Antonin Artaud or Angry Anderson (initials)
- 12 Ahmed Yassin or Angus Young (initials)
- 13 Celebrated Roman architect (Pantheon) and general (defeat of combined fleets of Antony and Cleopatra in battle of Actium of Sept 2<sup>nd</sup> 31 BC in Ionian Sea)
- 16 “In the world which will be renewed / And where He will give life to the dead / And raise them to eternal life / And rebuild the city of Jerusalem / And complete His temple there / And uproot foreign worship from the earth etc.” Jewish prayer of mourning said to express that even in the midst of loss one still praises G-d

- 1 Hard-bitten reporter known for investigating supernatural events in Chicago in 70s (played by Darren McGavin with evocative, neo-noir voiceover delivered by charismatic star)
- 2 *Ooie ...* Smash hit from 80s by greatly loved Pakistani pop duo Nazia and Zoheb (prior to sad death of Queen of South Asian Pop)
- 3 Anti-papist, proto-Protestant, follower of English dissident scholastic John Wycliffe (named derisively with term meaning to mumble or mutter)
- 4 Popular US powdered fruit drink invoked in ubiquitous meme about blind acceptance (4-3)
- 5 Andrew Ollie or Agent Orange (initials)
- 6 Sadly missed US singer called the Queen of Urban Pop (*Rock the Boat*) (also actress inc. role of 6,000-year-old vampire queen Akasha in film about vampires taking over music industry in 90s (filmed in St Albans with three hundred Melbourne goths recruited as extras for big concert scene in Werribee))
- 9 Popular Jimmy Swaggart Ministries Family Worship Center singer from Louisiana (*Praisin’ the King of Kings* etc.)
- 14 Georges Auric or Gary Ablett (initials)
