- 37** Popular fried chicken franchise (from Korean for “Yes! Yes!” expressing willingness of Koreans to put the best effort in any kind of situation with a positive mind)
- 41** Authors of disparate texts *Message to the Black Man in America, The Good the Bad and the Ugly, The Scream* and *Dürer: Innsbruck, 1495* (with finest lines in Australian poetry “I am still the black swan of trespass on alien waters”) (initials)
