- 8** Initials shared by most famous little girl in Nazi Germany (called by journalist Douglas Reed “a sort of Nazi Crown Princess”) and Austrian author of ubiquitous, plodding tome *The Story of Art*
- 9** Hans Eysenck *or* Hindley Eamshaw (initials)
- 10** One Europe (initials)
- 11** That which passes all understanding in droll Anglican witticism (initials)
- 13** Mission: *Impossible* *or* Morton Isaacson (initials)
- 15** “I’m afraid. I’m afraid. Dave. Dave, my mind is going. I can feel it. I can feel it. My mind is going. There is no question about it. I can feel it. I can feel it. I can feel it. I’m afraid” Movie villain from 60s known for memorable death scene
- 16** Pertaining to 16th century council convened by Catholic church in Trent to confront threat to hegemony posed by Luther and protestant Reformation
- 18** Adorable K-Pop singer from *tripleS* (also sub-unit *LOVELution*) and popular contestant on reality survival show *Girls Planet 999*
- 19** Another classic *Chisels* album (initials)
- 22** Florentine banking dynasty (missing at sea) **WARNING** cryptic
- 24** Motto of German army during WW1 inspiring witty rejoinder of British soldiers “We’ve got mittens too” (4, 3, 3)

- 26** International Democracy Union (initials)
- 27** One, two (Japanese) (4, 2)
- 28** *Hôtel du ...* Darkly poetic 1938 film by Marcel Carne best known for Arletty line on bridge over canal Saint-Martin: “Atmosphère! Atmosphère! Est-ce que j’ai une gueule d’atmosphère?”
- 30** Seminal 1941 horror movie with Lon Cheney Jr. memorable for eerie transformation scenes and creature walking on tiptoes through mist

- 1** Translation of Old Testament into Greek by seventy scholars hence the name
- 2** Popular Russian name (... Stravinsky, ... the Assassin etc.)
- 3** Initials shared by English philosopher known for characterization of life as “solitary, poor, nasty, brutish, and short” and controversial poet laureate known for bitter, cynical, surreal verse (*Crow* etc.) and killing wife (also girlfriend)
- 4** “..., ..., make us proud. Turn another ship around” Rousing chant at *Stand with Gaza* rallies meet State Library Victoria forecourt 12.00PM Sundays
- 5** Initials shared by celebrated authors of disparate texts *The Seventh Seal*, *White Christmas* and *In-A-Gadda-Da-Vida*
- 6** Mixed up prophet known for building ark, inventing wine, immutable curse on grandson used to justify transatlantic slave trade and promise from G-d, symbolized by rainbow, not to kill everyone again

- 7** Seminal New York punk band from 70s with Tom Verlaine also Richard Hell prior to dismissal for overexuberant performing style (leading to formation of *Voidoids* and release of *Blank Generation* in 1977)
- 12** Long, tasseled item of liturgical dress worn by priests around waist confining Alb while performing Mass symbolizing chastity
- 14** Unfriendly, hostile, tending to obstruct or harm
- 15** Ancient religion based on vision of universe as suffused with divinity the ultimate goal of life being to realize you are god
- 17** Body part of slain dragon sown by mythical hero Cadmus growing into fully armed warriors or Spartoi (lit. sown men) in ripping myth about foundation of ancient “seven-gated” Thebes
- 20** Committee [for] Open Discussion of [the] Holocaust (initials)
- 21** Ahded Tamimi (initials)
- 23** *Holiday ...* Controversial 1941 Christmas movie starring Bing Crosby and Fred Astaire shocking to modern audiences due to casual racism of 40s inc. tribute to Abraham Lincoln in blackface
- 25** Morton Isaacson *or* *Mission Impossible* (initials)
- 29** *Die Walküre* (initials)
