- 13** Wise wolf mentor of Mowgli in *Jungle Books*
- 14** Vast empire in central Asia founded by Genghis Khan in 13th century
- 16** "... mi tangere" ("Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father") enigmatic words of risen Christ to Mary Magdalene in John 20
- 17** Formerly Schedule 1 psychoactive narcotic now available in gummy bears (from 7-11)
- 18** Leading alcopop producer known for brightly coloured cans and beverages such as raspberry vodka aimed at underage drinker

- 21** Mysterious, crystal-clear sea in Atlantic Ocean associated with pioneering *Jane Eyre* prequel by Jean Rhys
- 24** "It's / Someone's dropped a bomb somewhere contaminating atmosphere and blackening the sky / It's / Someone's found a way to give the rotting dead a will to live go on and never die etc." Gloomy *Hedgehoppers Anonymous* hit of 1965 *It's* (initials)
- 25** Traditional way of addressing judge (in UK)
- 26** Why Karol Wojtyła, Roman Polanski, Szymon Perski, Walerian Borowczyk, Klaus Kinski and Lech Wałęsa have shiny shoes
- 27** Angie Dickinson *or* Agnus Dei (initials)
