### Across

- 1** Courageous New Zealand pop star slurred by Rabbi Shmuley Boteach as a bigot and anti-Semite supporting fiscal destruction of Israel by cancelling concerts in Tel Aviv in support of Palestinian rights
- 4** Captain Queeg (initials)
- 6** Adorable 60s pop star (*To Sir with Love* etc.)
- 8** Inexplicable name by which Yahweh identified Himself to Moses on Sinai (“Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, ... hath sent me unto you”) (1, 2)
- 10** Touching 1974 classic by Little Stevie Wright (in three parts)
- 11** Widely lauded Australian performer known for justification of 2017 Tel Aviv appearances as a “principled stand” against attempts by pro-Palestinian groups to “silence and censor” artistic freedom revealing essential cowardice and conservatism underlying posturing (4, 4)
- 13** Dwell on one’s success or the misfortune of others with smugness or malignant pleasure
- 14** Evil Queen (initials)
- 15** Belvedere, Spock, Ed, T, Baldy
- 17** Strange-looking way of writing “W” from 17<sup>th</sup> century (*Mr. ...illiam Shakespeares Comedies, Histories, & Tragedies; Miracles Lately ...rought by the Intercession of the Glorious Virgin Marie; The ...itch* etc.) (1, 1)
- 19** Famous Scottish stone
- 22** Famous resistance organization committed to expulsion of invader and liberation of country by violent means (4, 4)

### Down

- 1** Courageous Scottish psychoanalyst (“I am still more frightened by the fearless power in the eyes of my fellow psychiatrists than by the powerless fear in the eyes of their patients”)
- 2** Movie genre mostly with Hugh Grant
- 3** The 144,000 chosen by God for salvation in Revelation
- 4** Colonialist entrepreneur and architect of British Raj regarded by one historian as an “unstable psychopath”
- 5** Tattooed cannibal in 19<sup>th</sup> century American literary classic known for building own coffin
- 7** Beautiful American university founded by Thomas Jefferson in 1819
- 9** Trouble or afflict in mind or body
- 12** Geological environment characterized by the presence of caves, sinkholes, subterranean waterways and aquifers such as the Gihon Spring where ancient Israelites erected the Tabernacle and built the Temples
- 16** Quirky character depicted with bald head and pendulous nose hanging over brick wall in inexplicable graffito of military origin
- 17** US actress (Ethel Mertz etc.) (initials)
- 18** Early German cruise missile or “flying bomb” deployed in air war with Britain known by Allies as a “doodlebug” and in Germany as *Vergeltungswaffe* (“revenge weapon”) conveying mindset of German militarism as a *response* to aggression
- 20** Cliff Clavin (initials)
- 21** Poetically named program instigated by Reichsführer Heinrich Himmler involving the clandestine abduction and disappearance of political dissidents (into the “night and fog”) and consequent terrorization of civilian population (1, 1)
